In many ways local officials were ill prepared for a war that would soon reach deep into the West African colonies. By 1950 the separate forms of schooling that had been crafted for colonial subjects had given way to a process of educational integration, as various groups of African and French actors struggled to define the new parameters and possibilities of citizenship.
