Outside world might be.

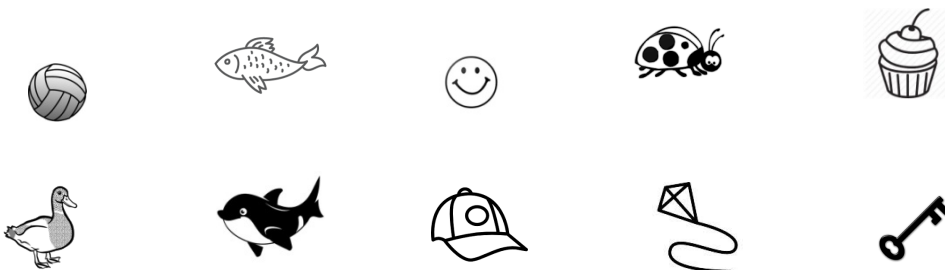

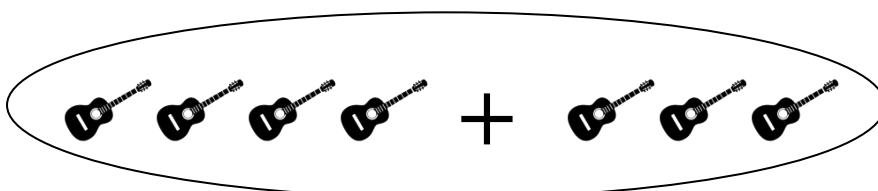
