Jesus of Nazareth (/É`dÉ`iÉZÉ`™s/; 7â€²2 BC/BCE to 30â€²36 AD/CE), commonly referred to as Jesus Christ or simply as Jesus or Christ, is the central figure of Christianity. Most Christian denominations venerate him as God the Son incarnated and believe that he rose from the dead The following study of Jesus' message and his person is based on this link.
