This is definitely not a doom & gloom book, and there were plenty of giggles and guffaws along the way, but this just not a frivolous look at levelling-up a bit. This is deeper and contains some hard truths for the reader as well as Tori: about changing relationships, facing our realities, and the gap between ourselves and even the closest of loved ones.
